Privatefirewall 7.0 is able to intercept the calls of WinAPI functions, initialization of new unknown processes, attempts to access protected file objects, and basically all “behind the scene” activity on your system, ensuring the best possible protection against all forms of malware including viruses, trojans, worms, spywares or rootkits and even Windows system exploits.

With its *Intrusion Detection and Prevention system*, the program is an effective protection against hackers attacks and their hiding techniques, therefore being much more than a simple firewall, offering unique capabilities focused on deviations of typical behavior, adapting and evolving along with the threats themselves.
